Falloween Fest Grand Parade 2019

Official Rules and Procedures for All Entries

(Please keep for your records)

1. All applications must be completed entirely, incomplete applications will be returned.
2. The Festival Parade Committee reserves the right to bar or remove from the parade any entry, which refuses to follow all instructions, from parade personnel.
3. All applicants will receive an official parade line up packet.
4. The number of vehicles or persons with each unit must be specified on the application and be approved by the committee. Only that number will be allowed to participate.
5. The signed Waiver of Liability and Hold Harmless Agreement must accompany application.
6. Horse entries are required to provide their own sanitation crews following unit or have diapers on horses.
7. Consumption or possession of alcoholic beverages or illegal substances is forbidden on all entries and participants. No alcoholic beverages will be allowed on the route or school grounds.
8. To ensure the quality of the parade, please be mindful of gaps between units. They cannot be more than 25 feet.
9. Participants must arrive at their designated staging area at the specified time, or they will not be allowed to participate.
10. The maximum number of people permitted in a unit is 35 with the exception of bands and military units.
11. All performances and acts of demonstration must be accomplished while moving forward. There are no exceptions to this rule.
12. Each unit will provide its own power supply. Setting up the idle speed of your vehicle may prevent stalling. The goal is to present a parade that flows smoothly. Approximately 2 mph allows for proper spacing and minimal gaps.
13. To assure your participation in the parade, entry forms must be received by September 7, 2018.
14. All entries are responsible for the supplies necessary for the set up and tear down of their unit.
15. All entrants are responsible for walking/inspecting the route before the parade to ensure the unit can clear any wires, trees, viaducts, street lights, corners, turns, etc. along the route, including the staging area and disembarking area.
16. Final positions will be determined by the Falloween Fest Grand parade committee.
17. All entries must be in line-up position, according to parade number by 4:30pm. The parade starts promptly at 5:15pm.
18. The rules and procedures are established to ensure a safe and enjoyable parade for everyone. ITEMS PROHIBITED: SQUIRT GUNS, FIRE HOSES, ETC.
19. The Falloween confirmation packet will have line up instructions, your parade entry number to be displayed, parade route and map and disbanding information. This will be mailed or emailed to entries.
